

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS:

BY CAR:

For directions to University of Massachusetts-Amherst by car, see http://www.umass.edu/umhome/visit_campus/directions.html. A detailed campus map can be found at www.umass.edu/umhome/visit_campus/map_detail_04.pdf. Focusing on the southeast section of the map, follow Massachusetts Avenue past the Robsham Visitors Center to the light, where the road curves and becomes North Pleasant Street. Bear right at this light; Gordon Hall is the modern building on the right just after the Baptist Church. The University Lodge is a few blocks further down North Pleasant Street on the left (toward the center of town). (The University Lodge is not shown on the campus map.)

BY AIR:

The closest airport is Bradley International Airport in Windsor Locks, CT (approximate travel time to Amherst is 45 minutes-1 hour); Logan Airport in Boston, MA is approximately 2 hours. Follow the “From the East or West via I-90” travel directions on the UMass website.

BY TRAIN:

The Amtrak train station in Springfield, MA is approximately 30 minutes travel time from Amherst. For train schedules, see www.amtrak.com. Follow the travel directions “From the South” on the UMass website.

The Amtrak station in Amherst is limited to one train per day.

SHUTTLE SERVICES:

For ground transportation service from the airports or the Springfield Amtrak station, we recommend the following shuttle services: Valley Transporter (800-872-8752) at www.valleytransporter.com, or Michael’s Limousine (800-533-8470) at www.michaels-limo.com/. Others are listed on the UMass and airport websites.

PARKING:

There is very limited parking at Gordon Hall. Participants staying at the University Lodge should leave their cars there and simply stroll back down N. Pleasant Street two blocks to Gordon Hall. On the weekend only, participants can park in Lot #34 (the closest university lot to Gordon Hall) without a permit. This lot is restricted Monday-Friday. The closest public parking Monday-Friday is at the RobshamVisitors Center.
